

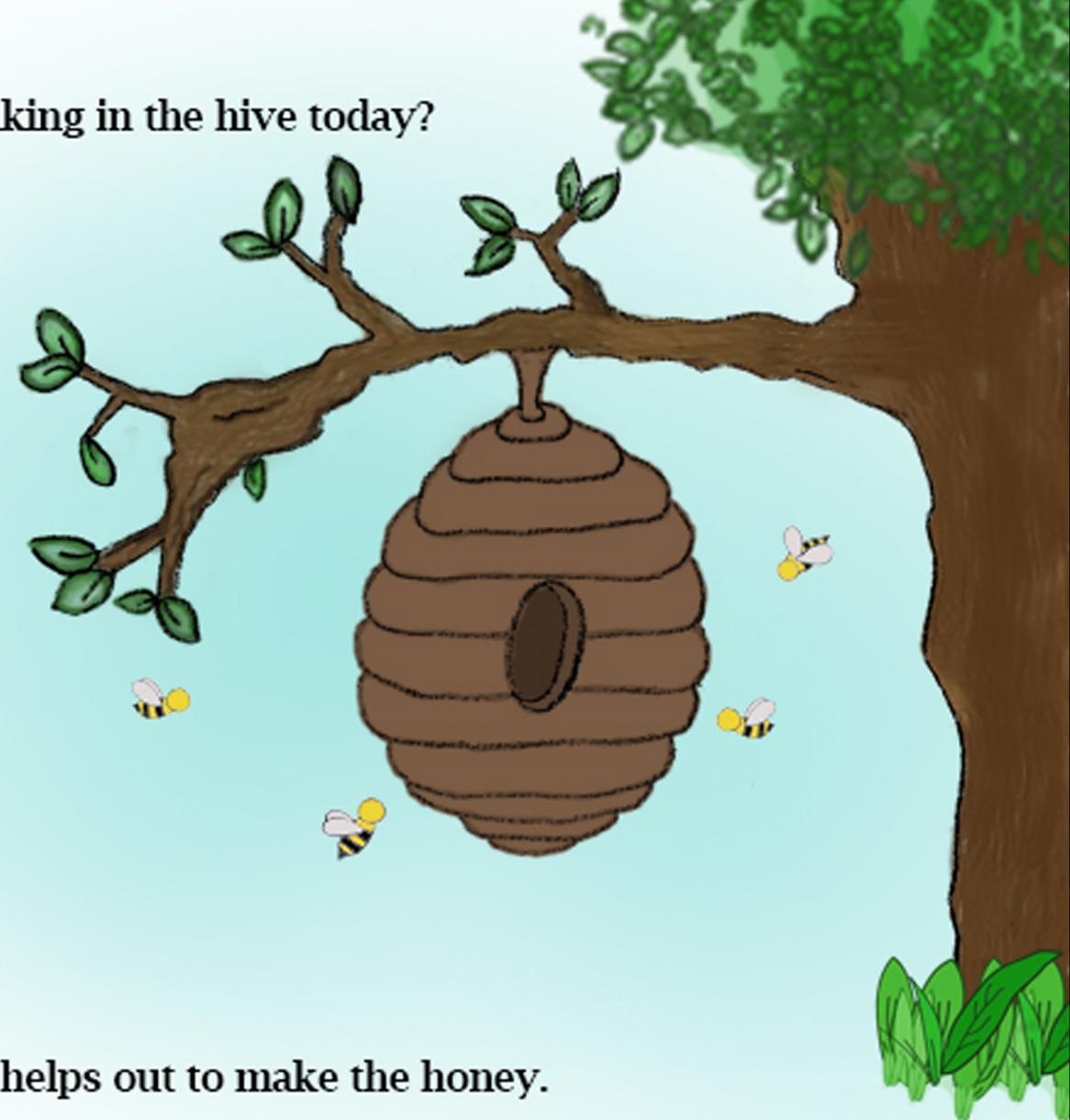

Timmy flies to find a big patch of flowers.

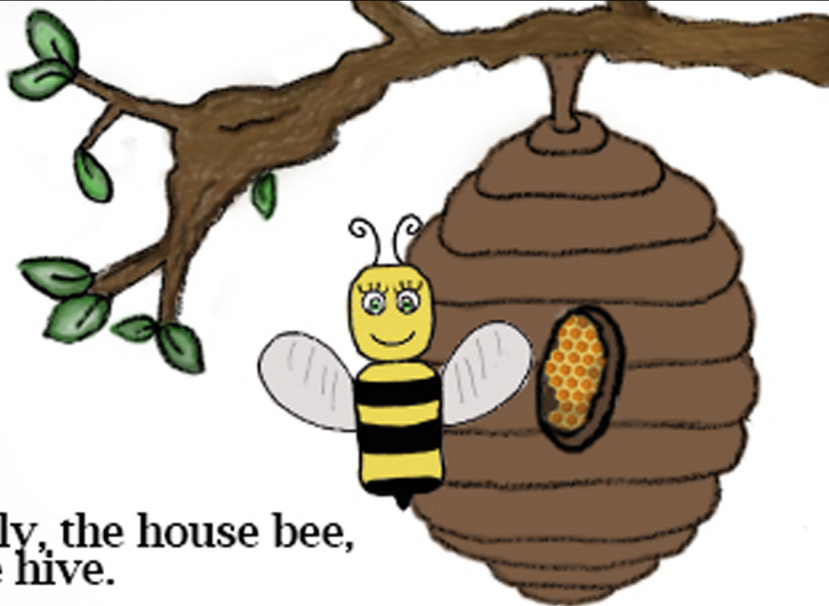


Sally joins Timmy and they do a bee dance to point the other bees to the tasty nectar!



Alfie and Jerry arrive! They take the nectar from the flowers and fly back to the hive.





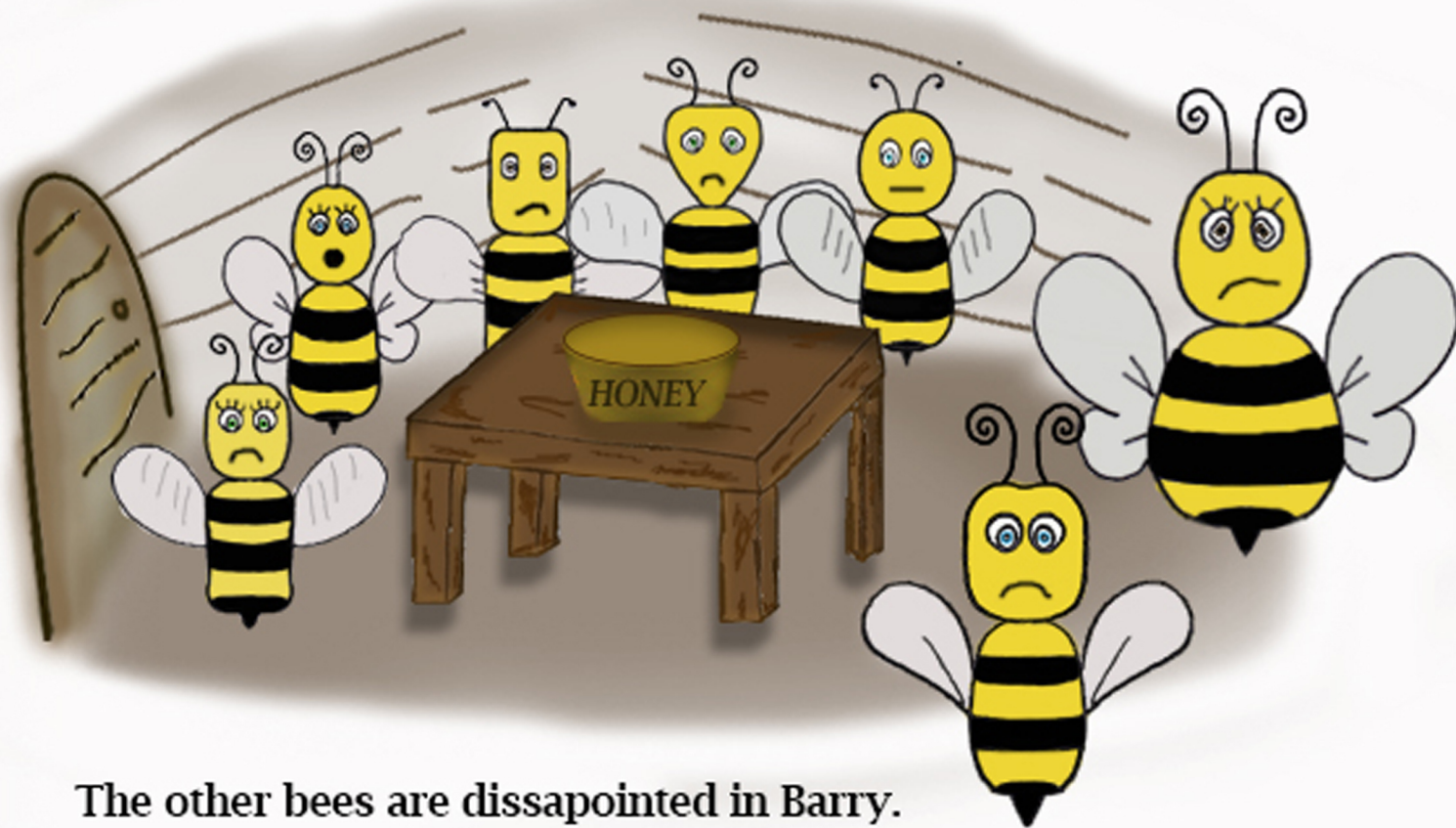
Alfie and Jerry pass the nectar to Holly, the house bee, who puts it in the honeycombs of the hive.

Said Mummy Bee. "We bees work together as a team, and everyone needs to do their part!"

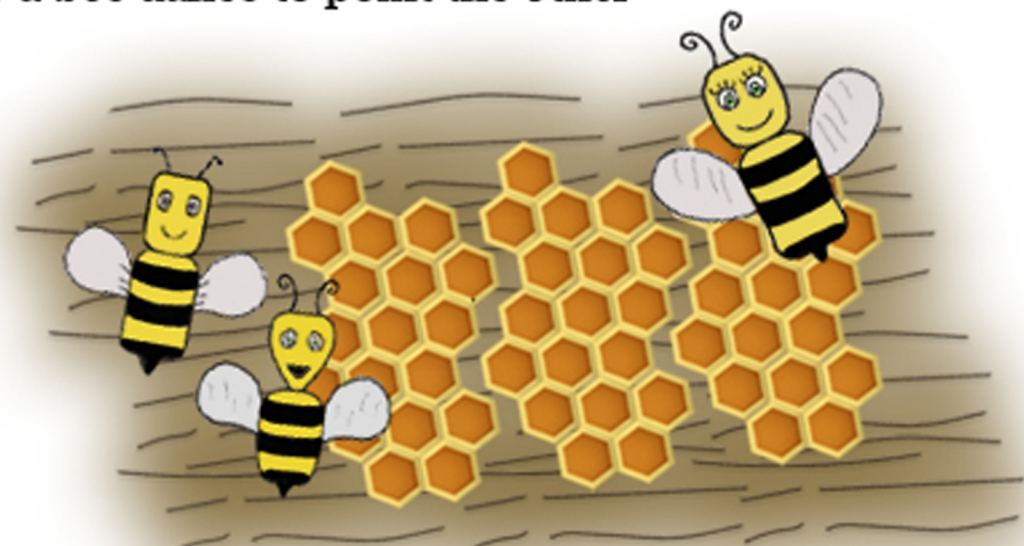


The other bees are dissapointed in Barry.



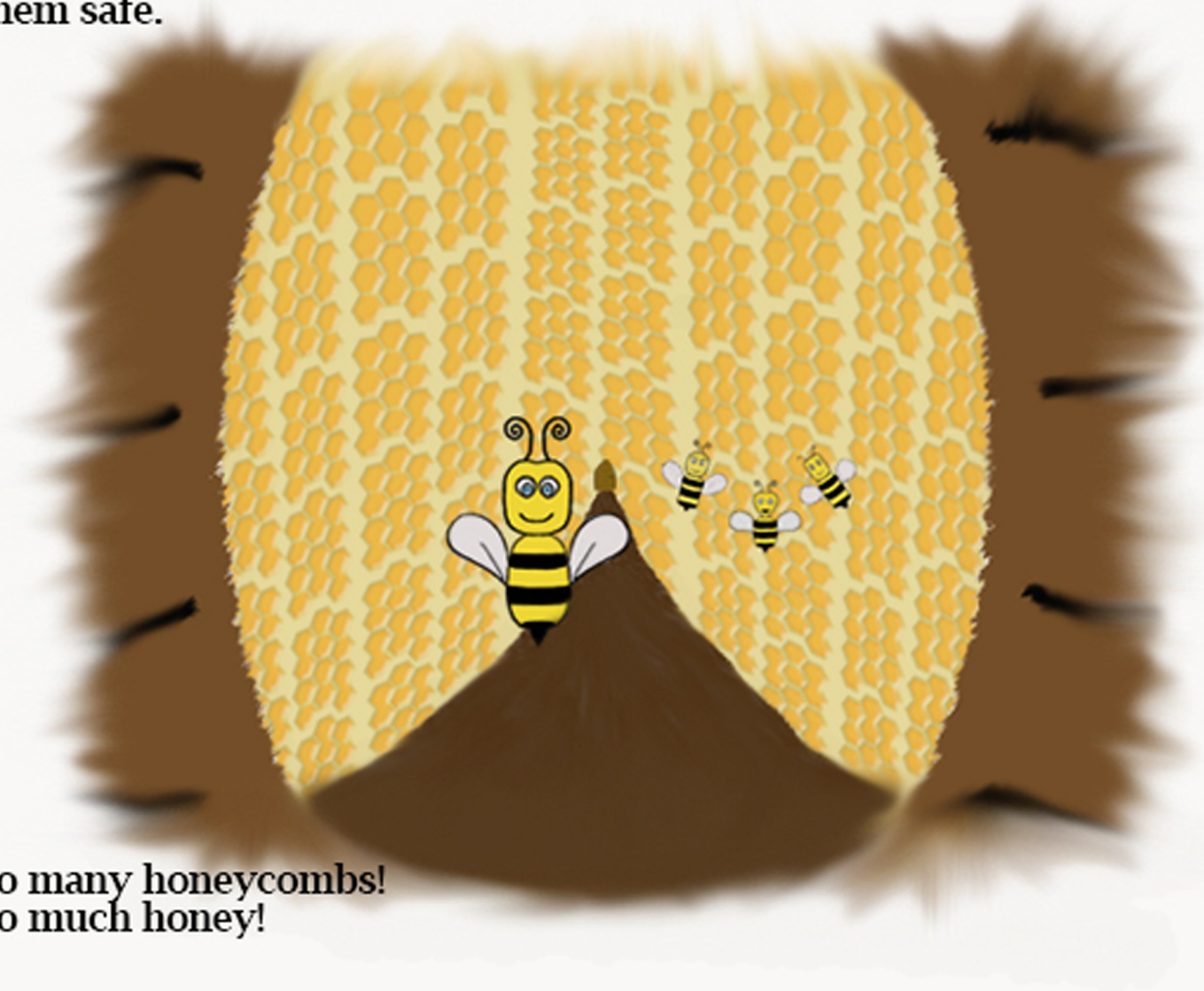


The next day, Timmy flies to find a big patch of flowers. Sally joins Timmy and they do a bee dance to point the other bees to the tasty nectar!



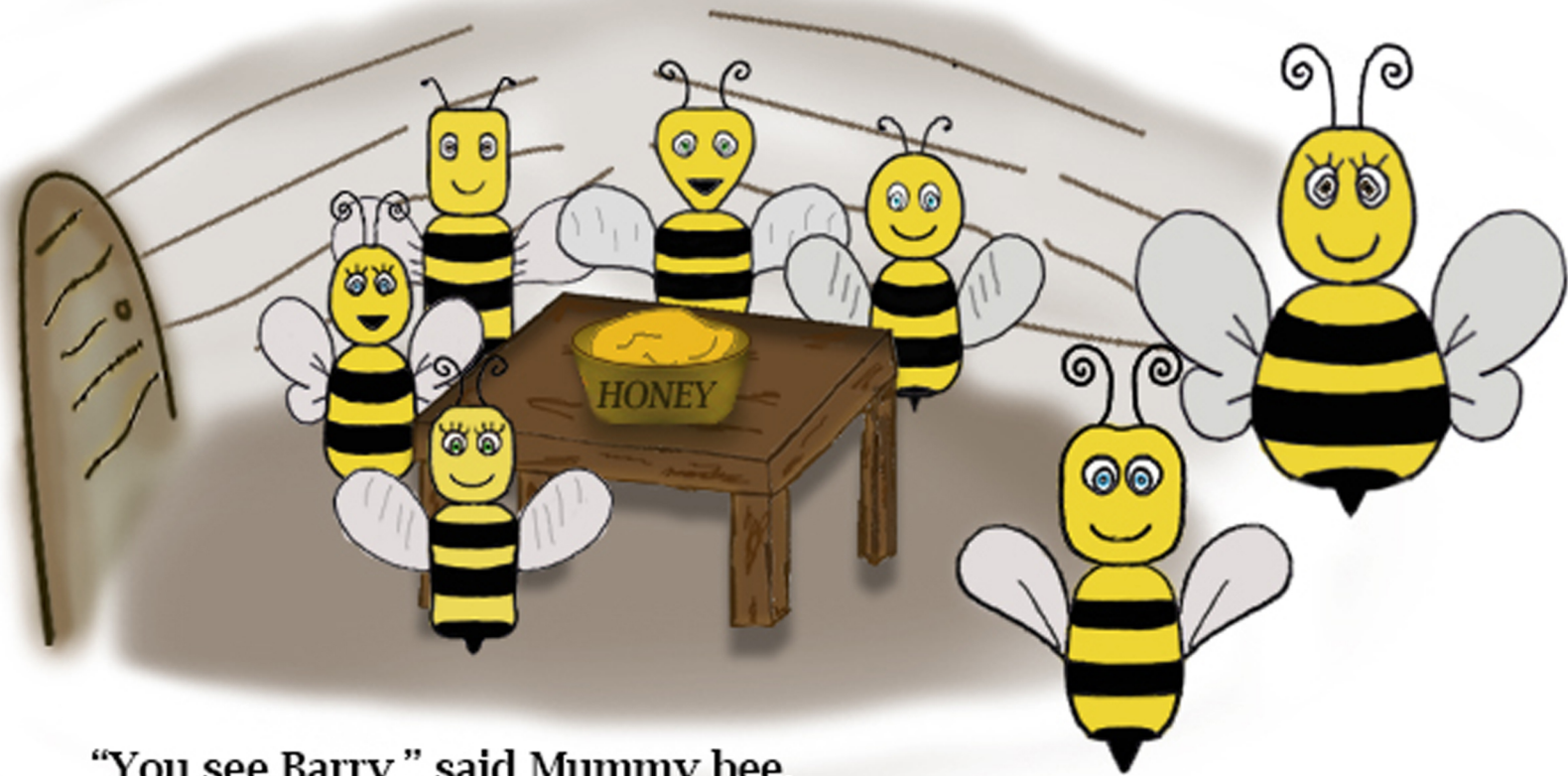
